

Observational Experience for the Cedar Crest College Nurse Anesthesia Program Applicant

As part of the application process, the applicant is required to schedule an observational day with a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA) for one eight hour shift.

- This is an observational experience only. There is no patient care of any kind given by the applicant.
- The applicant must abide by the policies and procedures of the institution.
- The observational experience must be in an Operating Room (OR) or a Non-Operating Room Anesthesia (NORA) clinical area within the institution. Medical or dental offices are not acceptable.
- The applicant must have the form signed by the CRNA at the end of the observational experience and upload it with the application.
